### **Alien & Predator Marathon**




The insignia for the Alien & Predator Marathon features the emblem for the Weyland-Yutani Corporation prominently displayed at the top. All aspects of life revolve around the Company. The Company is first and foremost. Everything else is secondary. Human lives are meaningless to the Company. Crews are expendable.

The marathon's name is below the Weyland-Yutani logo, the two components written in each series' respective typeface. Below that are Predator glyphs that spell out the tagline for *Alien vs. Predator*: "Whoever wins, we lose." Never mind how forgettable that particular chapter of the franchise is, its tagline is appropriate for both series as a collective whole.
