# An Explanation of the Header Titles

Each page of this collection of election results includes a header for each column of figures. This is an explanation for what the abbreviations in the header means.

## **CANDIDATES**

Those individuals running for the presidency during a given election cycle. Candidates include their running mate (RM), who the presidential candidate intends to become their Vice President on that ticket. This is not always the case, especially pre-1804 when the Vice Presidency went to the opponent coming in second place, a system quickly abandoned. Vice Presidents are nominated individually by the party delegates, meaning that their presence as running mate on the ticket is not necessarily the final say.

### **PARTY**

The party is the body organized to support, finance, and promote the candidate. Typically only two parties run with third parties getting little support and recognition. To date, the most successful third party has been the Republicans, which emerged from the failing Whig structure in 1856, winning the presidency in 1860.

#### ST

The state (ST) that the candidates lived in while campaigning. Social differences across states often play important roles in how candidates approach their campaigns and running mates are frequently chosen from states with differing social climes. For example, a presidential candidate from a conservative southern state might generate more appeal across their base by selecting a running mate from a more liberal northern state, and vice versa.

The percentage (%) of the popular vote that each candidates won, divided between all parties running during the election.

#### PV

The popular vote (PV) is total number of votes cast by the overall nationwide electorate. Each popular vote accounts for an individual casting a ballot for their preferred candidate.

#### ΕV

The electoral vote (EV) is the total number of votes cast for a candidate by the Electoral College. Explained in Article II, Section 1 of the Constitution, the number of electors in each state is equal to the combined number of Senators and Representatives allotted to that state. Following the tallying of the popular vote, the electoral vote is taken. The intention is that the electors should vote in favor of the outcome of the popular vote.

#### SC

The number of states carried (SC) by each candidate on Election Day. Unfortunately, not all states are created equal. A candidate may win the entire cluster of central plains states but be in trouble if they lose California, a state whose population and number of electors may exceed all of those plains states combined.
