William Shatner was born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada on March 22, 1931. Best known for having played Captain James T. Kirk on Star Trek (1966-69), one mustn't forget his role as T. J. Hooker in the cop show of that very name (1982-86). Nowadays he plays Denny Crane on Boston Legal and is the official spokesman for Priceline.com.

This year Shatner is turning seventy-eight years old. In recognition of nearly a half century's contributions to the silver screen, Shatner Day honors the man, the legend, and the essence that is William Shatner.

The insignia for Shatner Day 2009 emphasizes his Star Trek past. The starship *Enterprise* rises through the center, bearing the event's name on its twin nacelles. The Starfleet delta, with Kirk's command star, points to the right ... towards the future and towards progress. The seven stars on *Enterprise's* saucer represent the seven Star Trek films that Shatner starred in. The last of these, *Generations*, featured the death of Kirk and stands alone in the center.

"The Ashes of Eden" is the title of Shatner's premier Star Trek novel, the plot of which features Kirk struggling to get his life back on track just prior to the events of *Generations*. The title was chosen for this marathon because Shatner Day 2009 is an attempt to restart the neglected movie day program: the mighty Phoenix rises back into the heavens from the ashes of Eden.
