William Shatner was born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada on March 22, 1931. Best known for having played Captain James T. Kirk on Star Trek (1966-69), one mustn't forget his role as T. J. Hooker in the cop show of that very name (1982-86). Nowadays he plays Denny Crane on Boston Legal and is the official Negotiator for Priceline.com.

This year Shatner is turning seventy-nine years old. In recognition of more than a half century's contributions to the silver screen, Shatner Day honors the man, the legend, and the essence that is William Shatner.

Shatner Day 2010




The insignia for Shatner Day 2010 emphasizes his Star Trek past. The starship *Enterprise* rises from the ruddy inferno of past grievances to seek avengement for all wrongs. The seven command stars along the bottom represent the seven Star Trek films that Shatner stared in. The three bright stars, taken from the seal of the United Federation of Planets, suggest not only the three seasons of the original series but also the third Shatner Day that we have celebrated while the Starfleet delta, with Kirk's command star, stands at the right.

"Avenger" is the title of Shatner's third Star Trek novel, the plot of which features Kirk and Picard battling a virus sweeping through the Federation as Spock learns that his father had been murdered. The title was chosen for this marathon because, not only is it the third in line, but also because this year begins a new decade. The previous ten years have left a sour memory for many and it is time to wake up and examine what went wrong, then do things right again, from day one.


