William Shatner was born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada on March 22, 1931. Best known for having played Captain James T. Kirk on *Star Trek* (1966-69), one mustn't forget his roles as T. J. Hooker in the cop show of that very name (1982-86) or attorney Denny Crane on *Boston Legal* (2004-08). He was also the host of *Shatner's Raw Nerve* on The Biography Channel (2008-11).

This year Shatner is turning eighty-three years old. In recognition of more than a half century's contributions to the silver screen, Shatner Day honors the man, the legend, and the essence that is William Shatner.

The insignia for Shatner Day 2014 pits the gallant crew of the starship *Enterprise* against a squadron of Romulan Birds of Prey, yet another perilous predicament during the multi-year mission of exploration. The patch is asymmetrical and disjointed, rendered mostly with red and yellow warning colors, all symbols of the unease, tension, and danger afoot.

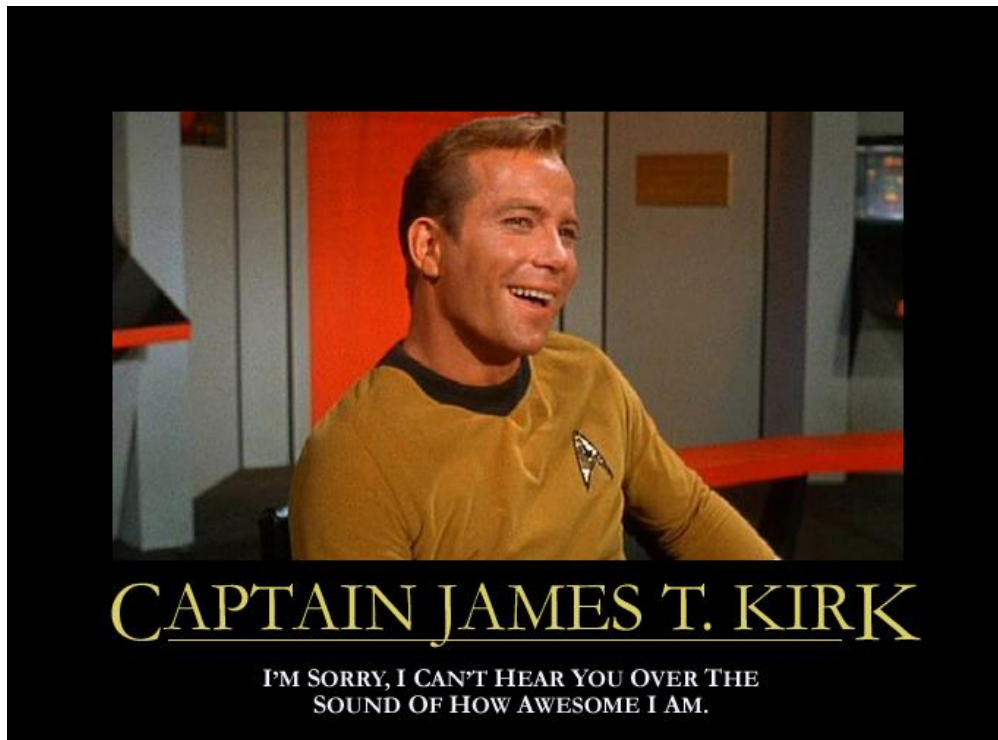
"Captain's Peril" is the title of Shatner's seventh *Star Trek* novel and the start of the "Totality" trilogy. This time around, Captains James T. Kirk and Jean-Luc Picard, stranded during an expedition on Bajor and unable to contact Deep Space 9, must work together while Kirk has flashbacks to a very similar situation many years before. Will the captains escape their peril? Will they save a trapped child in time? Will Kirk die? Again? Questions indeed, in this first chapter of the last trilogy.
